BQE Software Debuts two new cross-platform, web enabled products.  
Web i ASP Reports and Web i ASP Time Card - both are add-on products to its popular  
BillQuick® Time Billing Software

The applications enable users-computer consultants, engineers, architects, programmers, attorneys, accountants, designers, and other professionals-to generate project management reports and record time while working on-the-go. They are Intranet/Internet based applications, which use Active Server Page (ASP) technology.

The applications use BillQuick security, giving each user only the access he or she has been assigned by the administrator. These are must have tools for remote consultants, project managers and satellite offices.

Web i ASP Reports provides the powerful reporting capability of BillQuick using a Java based application as a report viewer. The reports can be printed or exported to several popular formats.

Web i ASP Time Card handles the review, editing and creation of time entries.

These products are available now as add-ons to both BillQuick 2000 and BillQuick enterprise or in a suite that includes the parent application. BillQuick differs from general accounting software, which may include a billing module, in that its architecture is open and its billing options are virtually limitless. Set-up criteria include fixed-fee, time-and-expense, hourly billing, hourly billing with not-to-exceed, and contractual billing based upon percentage or progress payments of a fixed fee. This adaptability allows the program to serve the defined needs of specialized professions. It also separates BillQuick from simple time card software, which are centered on hourly billing.

BillQuick, currently in version 3.0, was first introduced in 1996 as a time management product. It has since grown into a complete billing system that includes project management tools as well as a powerful timecard. The program performs project phasing, billing against retainers, expense

tracking, and analysis reporting-tools that both monitor projects and support profitability. BillQuick reviews client data and bills intelligently at set intervals. The application's timecard gives employees access to the system to enter their time but protects confidential information. Fee schedules in the software allow billing rates to be assigned to any combination of employee, activity, and project. All reports, statements and invoices can be customized with Crystal Reports 7.0.

BillQuick's flexibility suits all types of companies. Many other add-ons are available for BillQuick, including eTools and BillQuick Palm; they offer time entry and expense recording functions via email and PDAs. As an open-architecture application, BillQuick permits add-ons and custom modules to suit all types of companies, from a one-person office to a large network-based organization. It can exchange data with many other software programs, including SQL Server, Access and Excel.
