ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice Installation Preparation

Please read these instructions carefully. If you are not prepared for your installation session, you will be rescheduled and charged a rescheduling fee for this service.

- 1. ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice 2016 must be hosted on a server or workstation that meets our minimum requirements. If using a workstation and having more than 5 users, we recommend a dedicated machine hosting only ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice. In addition, if you choose to use a client operating system on either a server or workstation, such as Windows 8 Professional, please note there might be IIS connection limitations if you have more than 10 users. Windows 8 allows 10 concurrent connections (this is a restriction by Microsoft).
- 2. Confirm your server (host) computer meets the minimum requirements for ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice 2016. *See <u>System Requirements</u> for details.*
- 3. If ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice is to be hosted on a server: Our BQE Consultant will need to connect to your client workstation with a remote desktop connection to the server. Therefore, before your scheduled installation session, please make sure you are able to perform a remote desktop connection to your server.
 - If ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice is to be hosted on a workstation: Our BQE Consultant will establish a remote connection directly to your workstation.
- 4. The server must have an internal static IP address.
- 5. The server that will host ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice on it should have UAC (User Access Control) *TURNED OFF* (this will require a restart) or turned down, if you are running Windows Server, Windows Vista, Windows 7 or Windows 8.
- 6. An Internet connection is required for remote access to your computer so our BQE Consultant can perform the installation.
- 7. Log in as a local administrator.
- 8. *MAC users*: If you do not plan on purchasing a computer (PC) for your ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice 2016 server, please note that you must use VMWare Fusion to create a virtualized workstation (see the <u>Set up Mac for ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice</u> whitepaper for more). Memory for your Mac has to be at least 6 GB (2 GB for Mac OSX and 4 GB for the Windows VM).
- 9. Prior to your scheduled installation, download the necessary SQL and ArchiOffice/EngineerOffice 2016 installation files from the following location (please download but *do not* run them. These will be installed during the scheduled session). Note the BQE Consultant can download a different edition of SQL Server Express based on your machine's hardware and software configuration.
